Here is a how-to:</li> <li>- Follow this link <a href="http://geoportal.hawaii.gov/datasets/cchnl::view-tax-plat-maps/data">http://geoportal.hawaii.gov/datasets/cchnl::view-tax-plat-maps/data</a></li> <li>- There are 3 tabs below the map and you should be in the "Overview" tab</li> <li>- Scroll down below the tabs to top left rectangle and click "Tax Plat Maps"</li> <li>- Scroll back up to the map, O'ahu should be covered by blue shapes w/white outlines</li> <li>- Click on the "Data" tab right below the map. There should be TMK plats for download listed, you can sort them or click link to map pdf on right</li> <li>- Next, zoom in to the area of the map you are interested in, using + and - buttons at top right</li> </ul>
